Notice of Board Elections W 🖳





The Board of Directors has nominated candidates for two open seats on the Board. Gary Faubion and Jay Brown have each been nominated to serve another three-year term. A retired GM Foundry employee, Gary is a long-time credit union volunteer. He has been a Board member for 46 years, serving in every officer capacity during his tenure. Jay Brown was first appointed in 2018 to fill an empty seat on the Board, having briefly served on the Supervisory Committee prior to his appointment. He is an engineer at NSWC Crane.

The Supervisory Committee has nominated candidates for two open seats on the Committee. Don Brandt has been nominated to serve another three-year term. Don has served as a Credit Union volunteer for 23 years. Janie Craig Chenault has been nominated to complete the remaining one-year term for the seat she was appointed to fill in June 2018.

One additional seat is being filled by appointment by the Supervisory Committee. This seat became available when Committee member Jay Brown moved to fill an open Board of Directors position. Tara Jenkins has been appointed to serve beginning January 1, 2019, until the annual election, at which time her seat will be up for election. She has also been nominated to continue to serve a full term on the Committee. A long-time resident of Orleans, Tara is the Director of Quality at Southern Indiana Rehab Hospital in New Albany, IN.

If you are a Credit Union member, at least 21 years of age, and are interested in running for the Board of Directors or Supervisory Committee, you can pick up an official petition and candidate application form at our Bedford Annex Building at 630 Lincoln Avenue in Bedford.

To have your name placed on the ballot, the petition must be signed by 5% of the Credit Union members who are at least 16 years of age. Return it, along with the completed application form and a picture of yourself, to the Credit Union by noon on Tuesday, February 5.

If there is only one nominee for each position to be filled, the election will not be conducted by ballot, and there will be no nomination from the floor, as the nominees will be elected to the positions by acclamation. If an election is necessary, ballots will be mailed with the first quarter member statements. Ballots will need to be received by the election teller no later than midnight, May 10, 2019.

Election results will be announced at the Hoosier Hills Credit Union Annual Meeting on Wednesday, May 15, 2019. The meeting will be held in the HHCU Service Center lobby, 630 Lincoln Avenue, Bedford, IN, beginning at 6:01 p.m.
