

Improvements Coming to Jasper Service Center

One of many hallmarks throughout HHCU's 50 years of service to southern Indiana is thoughtful, measured growth that positively impacts members and employees. The Service Center at 3010 Newton Street in Jasper will soon undergo construction that is designed to enhance one of the Credit Union's founding principles.

"We conduct approximately 50,000 transactions each year at the Jasper Service Center, and this project is going to help us continue to improve the services we offer our members," said Andy Fish, Chief Retail Officer.

Jason Hagen, VP of Operations at the Jasper Service Center, agrees. "We are excited to have the space to utilize for the current and future growth of the Jasper market," Hagen said.

The entire second floor—nearly 2,900 square feet—will be renovated, and the finished space will include offices, restrooms, training/conference space and a new work area. Work is scheduled to begin later this spring.

Avoid Donation Scams

You work hard to earn and protect your money, but unfortunately, there are scammers who work just as hard to try to take it from you. This can be especially true at tax time, when many people are searching for last-minute donation ideas. Here are some tips on how to avoid becoming the victim of a donation scam

Watch for patterns. Scammers will typically ask victims to send money in forms more difficult to trace, such as cash, gift cards and wire or ACH transfers. The Federal Trade Commission recommends paying charities by check or credit card for more secure transactions.

Do your research. Many donation scams set up fake charity names that may sound legitimate. Check them out on

CharityNavigator.org to verify the organization is what they claim to be. Most reputable charities have website addresses that end in .org instead of .com, and their payment portal should be secure, so that you see "https" at the start of the payment page's address.

Watch for attachments instead of links. Real charities will often send a link to their website. Scammers, on the other hand, are more likely to include attachments that, when downloaded, can infect your computer and compromise personal information.
